EDUCATION LIAISON

The Education Liaison role involves:

- being responsible within the ADNA committee to ensure ADNA becomes a Professional organisation which promotes high quality Dermatology Nursing education to all members and those browsing;
- facilitating adequate specialisation training for those working in the field of Dermatology Nursing
- facilitating clear educational pathways (such as Diploma, post-diploma certificates in Dermatology, Degrees or Post graduate certificate, Masters in Nursing; and Career prospects for ENs, RNs to CNCs to NPs.
- A nurse having Higher education skills, at least Honours level, a willingness to create a team of dermatology- educated people to strive to achieve high quality educational goals for ADNA. This role is a self or member nominated position, appointed at the time of the AGM.
- Liaising with larger organisational bodies in Australia and Internationally: ACD, ACN, CoNMMO, ISNG, BDNG, ADN, ACORN, ACCDS and other cosmetic/dermal educational bodies;
- Ensuring Conference and State education day content meets CPD requirements, as the ELO appoints CPD to events;
- Assisting State representatives with organising the State education days. (and the content is educationally sound. Obtain attendee feedback—ensure evaluations are completed online in order to have CPD issued.
- Ensuring access to relevant information and current online modules for all members.
- Incorporating International connections for educational events and learning pathways to benefit ADNA members
- Provide input related to Educational content for newsletter and website links;

It requires humility and team work. It requires integrity and yet confidentiality. The ADNA committee serves the membership.

**(Formally APEC/ACN liaison) APEC is an ACN model of endorsement for educational events and activities where the provider is given status or authorised, on behalf of ACN, to endorse their own activities for a period of two years.
